	Founded in October 2017 as an exhibition space in the former Azur factory , LAPSUS became a nonprofit organization in 2019. For seven years, we have organized exhibitions, workshops, residencies, affordable art fairs, mobilities and mentorship programs. We have built a strong community of supporters and collaborators, allowing us to expand into
